1st **WHAT IS AN APOSTLE?**

Matthew 10:1 Jesus summoned His twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal every kind of disease and every kind of sickness. 2 Now the names of the twelve apostles are these:

we command you 2 Thessalonians 3:6
with a rod 1 Corinthians 4:21

Acts 2:42-43 continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching...and everyone kept feeling a sense of awe; and many wonders and signs were taking place through the apostles.

Acts 5:12 at the hands of the apostles many signs and wonders were taking place among the people.

Hebrews 2:3-4 How shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation? After it was at the first spoken through the Lord, it was confirmed by those who heard 4 God also bearing witness with them both by signs and wonders and by various miracles and by gifts of the Holy Spirit according to His own will.
